Kayne Griffin Corcoran boasts a space that allows visitors to completely leave the bustling Hollywood landscape behind as they enter through the gallery gates into a kind of serene outdoor sanctuary; an effect made more palpable by details inside, such as a James Turrell ceiling in the conference room. On July 12, despite the heat and the traffic, there was an impressive turnout at the unique space for the opening of *Contort Yourself*, a self-described “series of solo exhibitions disguised as a group show.” The exhibition, curated by The Modern Institute, includes works by Luke Fowler, Jim Lambie, Jonnie Wilkes and Sue Tompkins, and demonstrates just how good a summer group show can be. Tompkins even gave a special performance for the Saturday night opening. If you haven’t seen it yet *Contort Yourself* is a great show to check out as we head into the so-called dead of summer. It will be up through August 30.
